We have countless events going on at our busy school and not enough stands to facilitate spectator viewing and those we do have are massive and not easily relocated. These ones we have selected and need can be easily moved by our estate staff



They're 100% recycled plastic packaging, long lasting and maintenance-free - but not cheap!

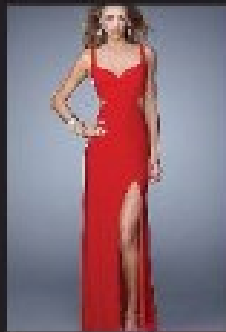
