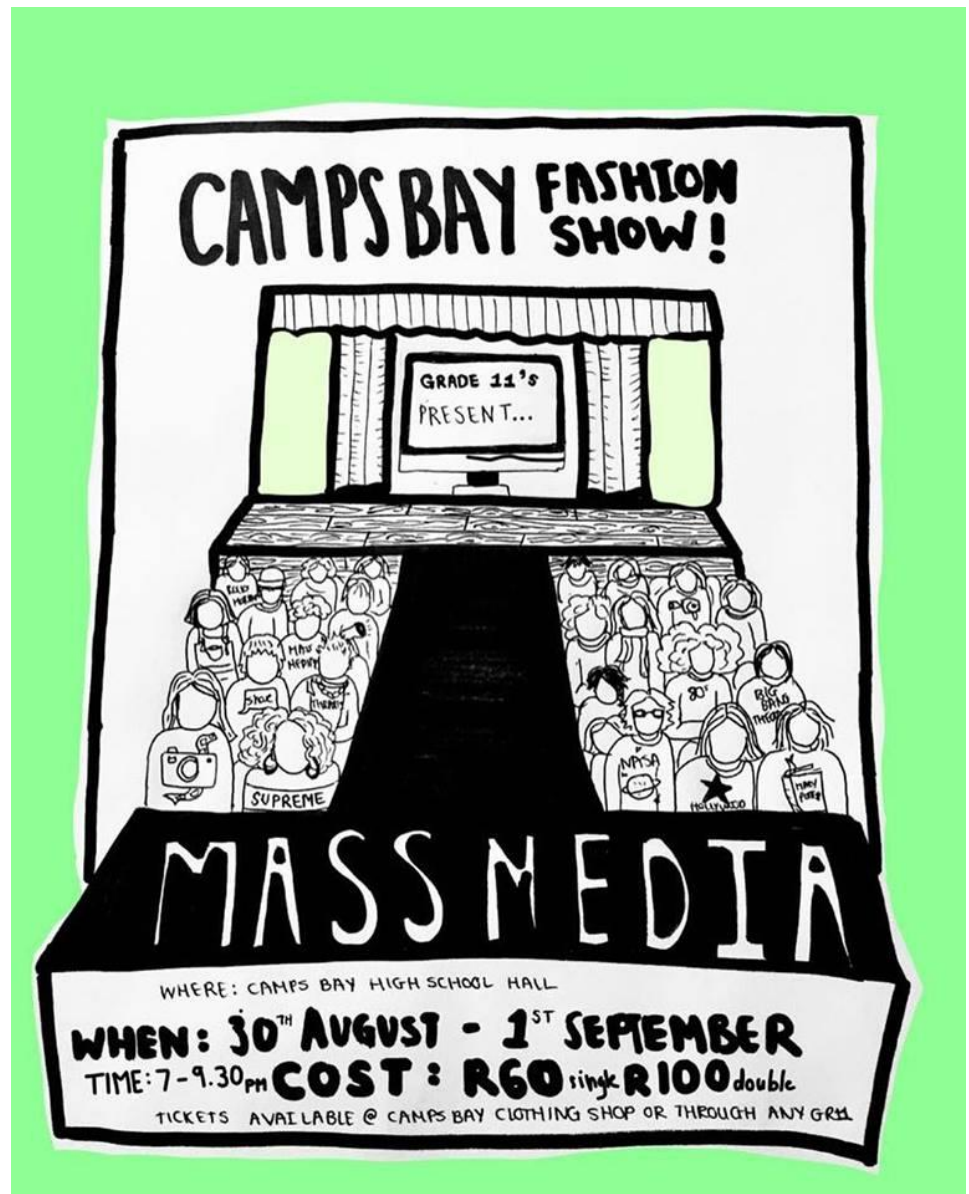


Grade 11 Fashion Show - #Massmedia - Thursday 30, Friday, 31 August and Saturday, 1 September 2018
