Dear Parents

The abduction of children has been featured in the media over the last few weeks. The WCED has asked all schools to flag this and create awareness with our pupils and parents around these dangers in our society at present. With this in mind I addressed the school on Monday regarding how to be safe. For your interest I will briefly repeat the points below.

I started by encouraging all pupils to be alert and aware of their surroundings. I mentioned that there is a big difference between sitting outside the front entrance after school 'lost' in thought or listening to music and sitting at 18h30 on the station waiting for a train. One environment is much 'safer' than the other and will need a totally different level of alertness.

Also it is much safer in a group. So, where possible, stick together and look out for each other.

Then there is the need for wisdom regarding when and where they go. One venue may be totally safe at midday but not so safe at 23h00.

I also noted the need for our pupils to keep their phones charged and make sure they have airtime.

Communicating your movements is important when staying safe. You need to let the important people in your life know where you are and when you expect to arrive or depart.
