In this school I found the perfect fit for my personal leadership style and character. I am so proud of the school and all it stands for and offers, for the things we value. Over my 18+ years here we have had the unique privilege of seeing countless teenagers move from just stepping into being a teenager, all the way through to launching them as young adults into the world. I have been (and continue to be) part of a team that have been engaged in this special work we call teaching and learning at Camps Bay High School.

So this is an early announcement to allow for proper planning and preparation, and ultimately a handover. However, there is a year ahead before all these things come to pass. You can be sure I am looking forward to 2020 at Camps Bay High School and have no intention of leaving with a “whimper” but rather am hoping and planning for a “blaze of glory!”

A discount of R1500.00 is granted if fees are paid in full for the year by 31 January 2020.

I would like to take this opportunity to clarify the payment structure of school fees, to avoid any future misunderstanding. Some parents seem to be unaware of the following:

CBHS is a PUBLIC SCHOOL i.e. a fee-paying school, and we abide by the following Western Cape Education Department resolutions:

Resolutions as per the Budget meeting: (SASA section 39, 40 and 41) (Held in November 2019)

1. Compulsory annual school fees for 2020 is R37 000.00 as adopted by the parents at the budget meeting.
2. School fees are payable in ADVANCE and are due on the FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.
3. Payment options are: Fees can be paid in full, OR
Fees can be paid in 10 monthly EQUAL instalments from 31 January to 31 October.
4. If school fees are paid in full on or before 31 January 2020 then a discount of R1 500.00 will be deducted from your annual school fees.
5. If parents are in arrear with ONE instalment, then the FULL amount becomes due and payable immediately. ACCOUNTS IN ARREARS ARE HANDED OVER TO OUR COLLECTION COMPANY.

If you require Application for Financial Assistance forms, please collect and sign for them in person from my office during the mornings only.
