Dear Parents,

We have our first official Corona Virus case in South Africa, and I am sure there be a few more before we are out of these "woods". The good news is that every day we learn more about this virus and how it affects people. We know that there are relatively few details from this "flu" and that it is really only a big risk for old people and people with pre-existing medical conditions. It lives in droplets, and so ingesting these droplets can infect you. Washing your hands can kill the virus. Cleaning flat surfaces can kill the virus. Having the virus on your hands is fine as long as you don't touch your face. The scary thing is that we touch our faces a lot. The wearing of a mask is not necessary unless you already infected and trying to protect others from your sneezes.



Decodance Party Night takes place on **Friday**, **20 March 2020**, from **20h00** until late! Strictly over 21!



U!9B Camps Bay vs Edgemead on the B field at 11h50


The **U19** Netball team will be playing multiple matches as follows:

BRONZE PRESIDENT'S AWARD HIKE



SUNDAY, 19 APRIL 2020

- Meet at Constantia Nek Parking Lot at 9am SHARP.
- Hike up the Jeep Track (Bridle Path) from Constantia Nek.
- Follow the track all the way to the Woodhead Reservoir.
- Hike across the dam wall, and carry on to the Scout Hut.
- Stop for lunch/snacks along the way.
- Rest before making own dinner and clean up after dinner.

- Breakfast at Scout Hut.
- Clean up Scout Hut before leaving.
- Follow the raised path (old railway track) to Kasteelspoort.
- Then follow the Pipe Track to Kloof Nek.

- Arrive back at school at approximately 1pm.


- Nights can get cold on top of the mountain.


