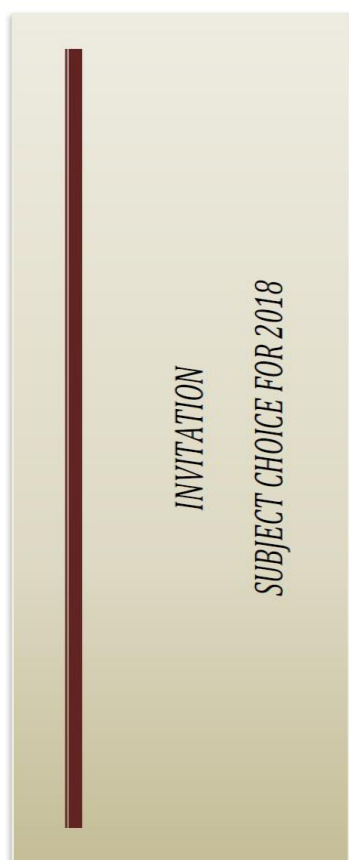

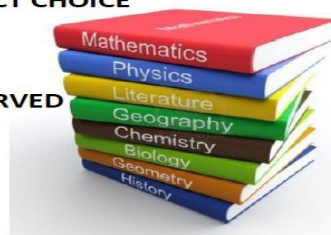

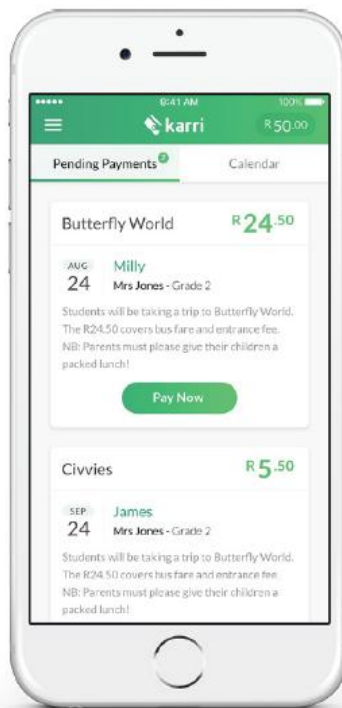
What is Karri?

MyCITI passengers can now load Mover packages at participating retailers and cash-accepting Absa ATMs.

You can load Standard and Mover points at cash-accepting Absa ATMs around the city.

To load value at cash-accepting ATMs you will need your **myconnect** card and cash, which needs to be inserted into the cash-accepting slot of the ATM.

To find the Camps Bay ABSA atm:

Go across the road, into the shopping centre entrance next to The Raj restaurant.

At the end of the passage, next to the elevator you will see the ABSA atm.

Steps to loading Mover at a cash-accepting Absa ATM

You can load Mover packages at cash-accepting Absa ATMs around the city. Please note that you need to insert the exact amount of cash into the ATM.

- 1 Insert your **myconnect** card
- 2 Select language of your choice
- 3 Enter your **myconnect** card PIN
- 4 Acknowledge terms and conditions
- 5 Select "Transit load"
- 6 Choose service provider "City of Cape Town"
- 7 Select "Transit stored value"
- 8 Select Mover package of your choice (R30, R50, R80, R100, R200, R400, R600, R1 000)
- 9 Confirm no rubber bands, staples, paper clips or coins
- 10 Insert exact amount in notes
- 11 Confirm transaction
- 12 Take your receipt
- 13 Take your card
- 14 Enjoy your MyCITI journey
