Dear Parents

Let me address a very boring topic, that of **lost property**. We seem to gather a mountain of lost property, mostly uniform items from our pupils. I asked Ms Murray how many of these items are marked with the owner's name and she estimated that only about one in five items are actually labelled. I was amazed at this, as each item costs someone money, often up to a few hundred rands. Please can I ask you to check that your child's uniform is labelled.

In Assembly today, **Mr Jenneke** addressed this, as well as the issue of 'taking someone else's possessions'. We have had a number of blazers 'taken' [read: stolen] out of a locker for Assembly and then dumped after Assembly.

This brings me to the second point that Mr Jenneke made, namely the bad habit of pupils not locking their lockers or in a rush and simply putting their bags on top of their locker for all to see.

He mentioned that we had had a case where a pupil's property (mostly uniform) had been stolen, but also we had learners reporting possessions stolen. Upon checking on the camera footage, we discovered that they had 'abandoned' their bags or left it somewhere else. The message that then goes home to parents is that it was stolen, when in fact it had been lost/misplaced. Parents are welcome to come to school and go through the lost property to see if their child's clothing is there. At the Parent/Teachers evening we will again make available all the lost property to allow you to look through and claim any items.

Social Media Policy

A summary of the school's Code of Conduct was sent home in the week. These are our school rules and no new rules have been added, just some updates. An example of this is that we have changed our confiscation policy of cell phones, where we will no longer be confiscating a cell phone, but rather issuing demerits when it is used in classroom without permission.

The section I would like to focus on is the last section that deals with our Social Media Policy. We are now ready to give every child access to WiFi on campus, but we just need every home to agree to our Social Media Policy. Please could you read this and sign the loose sheet (agreement) and return it to school by **Monday 12 March 2018**. Thank you for your co-operation.

Notice is hereby given that a meeting for the nomination and election of candidates for the election of parents (Parents of learners/educators/non-educators) as members of the governing body for the above-mentioned school will be held on 19 March 2018 at 5:30 p.m. at Camps Bay High School. Should a quorum not be reached, a follow up meeting will be held on 26 March 2018 at 5:30 p.m.


It shall be determined at 5:45 p.m. on the evening of the nomination and election meeting whether enough parents, entitled to vote, are present for the meeting to go ahead. Parents are therefore encouraged to attend the meeting, and to bring with them, their South African identity card or green barcoded identity document, or a temporary identity document issued by the Department of Home Affairs or, in the case of a foreigner, a permit issued in terms of the immigration Act, 2002 (Act 13 of 2002).

A candidate may be nominated at the meeting or by lodging with the school electoral officer, not later than seven days before the above meeting, a nomination form duly completed by the proposer, seconder and the nominated candidate. If more candidates are nominated than the number of members to be elected, a poll will be conducted after the nominations have been submitted.

RENAMING THE LITTLE GLEN NATURE RESERVE TO ARTHUR SHEPHARD LITTLE GLEN NATURE RESERVE

The City of Cape Town invites public comment on the proposal received that the Little Glen Nature Reserve be renamed in honour of Arthur Shephard.

The renaming submission is motivated for by the late Arthur Shephard, who in his personal capacity and mostly at his own expense, both in financial terms and time wise, coordinated the transformation of the Little Glen Nature Reserve from a run-down unsafe public space to an area that is well landscaped, secure and a community attraction, particularly for children. He achieved this with the cooperation of the local community, volunteers and the then City of Cape Town's City Parks Department.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input to the municipality from 1 to 31 March 2018.

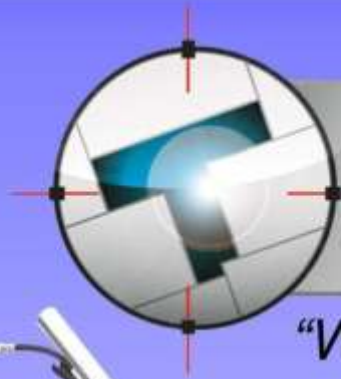
