Please note that Camps Bay High School is a declared <u>FEE-PAYING SCHOOL</u> in terms of the relevant legislation and that by enrolling your child at the school, you are under a statutory obligation to pay the school fees determined in terms of section 39 of the schools' act unless or to the extent that he or she has been partially exempted from payment in term of this act. I have read and accept the schools code of conduct. The school requires one academic term's written notice if a pupil is to be withdrawn from the school. On acceptance, a fee of R1 500 is due to secure your child's place and will be credited to your school fee account. This will be offset against the year's school fees. Please note that fees are payable over 10 months, with the first payment due by 31 January 2022, and the last payment by 31 October 2022.

- 1. The school fees with regards to an academic year, are payable in advance on the first day of school (SASSA section 39). An option of payment of 10 EQUAL monthly payments, 31 January 2022 to 31 October 2022 is offered. The parents(s)/guardian, with regards to a monthly payment plan, agree and undertake to effect such payment(s) on the due and agreed date, failing which, the full outstanding balance will be due and payable with immediate effect.
- 2. Parents Liability Section 39: A parent is liable to pay the school fees determined in terms of Section 39 of the School's Act unless, or to the extent that he or she has been partially exempted from payment in terms of this Act.
- 3. In the event of legal action being instituted, I elect as my domicilium citandi et executandi as stated in this form.
- 4. The school has the right to verify all information on this form.
