#### **Academics and Assessments**

After the early closure of schools last term, and the delay by one week of the learners returning after the holidays, we completed the outstanding assessments on Monday and Tuesday this week. We took a conscious decision last term in our planning not to schedule the assessment days in the first week of the return of learners, and we are so glad we did as we had up to 90 learners arriving late or not being able to attend school due to the taxi violence. Fortunately, this problem seems to have been sorted out.

The teachers have marked this week and will also do so over the long-weekend and marks are due on Tuesday morning. We then plan to complete the reports and we will hopefully be in a position to hand them out next week Friday, 13 August 2021

Despite the reduced teaching time due to the early closure and late start, the Grade 12 syllabus has remained the same and has resulted in some subjects having to make up the lost time on Saturdays and also by offering lessons after school. We have tried to limit these sessions as we know the Grade 12s are under pressure with regards to time, but we have no choice as the current time in class is not sufficient. The Grade 12 learners have been informed of these sessions. We are not too concerned with the other grades as the department will adapt the content and assessments accordingly, allowing us time to complete all the required work by the end of the year.
