School Finances

Last week we hosted the Annual Budget Meeting in the Drama Room. Camps Bay High School is a fee paying school and school fees have been determined and levied in accordance with the provisions of SASA section 39(1), 40 and 41 of the South African Schools Act.

The following resolutions were adopted at the budget meeting:

- Agree School Fees R39 900 per annum (Increase of R1 600 per annum)
- Agree Fee discount of R1 600 if paid in full by 31 January 2022.
- Agree Capex Spend of R874 900
- New Auditors appointed for 2021/22 audit
- Agree to 1 terms notice period for any learner leaving the school.
- Agree to R1 045 920 in S38 allowances for WCED teachers and R107 529 for the non-educators.
- Grade 8 School fee deposit for 2023 10% of school fees (Currently R1 500)
- If cash reserves are sufficient, and does not impact on the school's operational cash flow repay FNB loan (Currently R3 349 000 outstanding) without penalty, by June 2022.
- Agree to utilise CBHS financial assistance formula for school fee reduction in conjunction with the SASA formula.

School fees are essential to the survival of Camps Bay High School. It costs us about R30 million annually to run the school and we only get a contribution of R204 000 from the State. You can imagine that that R204 000 does not cover much OF our costs so we really need parents to pay their fees so that we can continue to offer quality education.

At present we have a total of 51 teachers and 28 Support/Admin Staff working at Camps Bay High School. The WCED only pays the salaries of 20 Teachers and 4 Support Staff. Thus 31 teachers and 24 Support Staff/Admin Staff are paid out of school fees.

If you are unable to pay school fees, either in part or in whole, you must apply for a reduction. There are various forms you will need to complete with our Assistant Bursar, Mrs Pearce. To make an appointment with Mrs Pearce to discuss, you can email her on mpearce@campsbayhigh.co.za.
